

Chess Club at Holy Spirit Preparatory

Championship Chess presents a systematic, fun way to build chess skills during chess instruction and while students play. Studies show that chess improves math, reading and problem-solving and our methods connect these academic benefits to our classes. Classes include instruction as well as chess play and guided analysis.

- **Day and Time:** Wednesdays from 3:00-4:00pm
- **Dates:** Fall session **August 31 to November 9.**
- **No chess:** October 19 early dismissal
- *Parents need to record these dates. Chess club will start as scheduled unless you receive notification.*
- There are 3 sessions per school year. Winter session starts **November 16.** Watch for new flyer at end of session.
- **Who can play:** This session is open to **ANY** student in 2nd through 6th Grade whether or not they know how to play. Younger students may participate if they only know how the pieces move and capture or if they have an older sibling in our chess club. Students who know how to play are encouraged to participate in local tournaments. For the club to meet there must be at least 12 students registered.
- **Cost: Fall Session Club Fee includes online access to Family Connection Site for instructional materials:**
 - **EARLY registration by Sunday August 28: \$135 per child for this session. A 15% discount for each additional sibling is automatically deducted in your online registration before going to payment screen.**
 - **LATE registration from August 29: A \$15 late fee is automatically added in your online registration.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY: Register by the deadline above: A child not registered on time, may not be on the roster sent to the school. Send a note to your teacher to dismiss your child to chess.
